Dr. Monica Prendergast, is Professor of Drama/Theatre Education, Department of Curriculum & Instruction, University of Victoria. Her research interests include curriculum studies and pedagogy, drama/theatre in community contexts, and arts-based qualitative research methods.

Carole Miller spent her early teaching career in elementary, middle and high schools. She is presently an emeritus professor at the University of Victoria where she continues to mentor pre-service students, exploring pedagogies that engender competent and comfortable classroom drama educators.

Juliana Saxton, a distinguished Professor Emeritus at the University of Victoria, transitioned from a career in theatre, television, and film to education. She has received numerous accolades for her publications on teaching drama and applied theatre.

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
