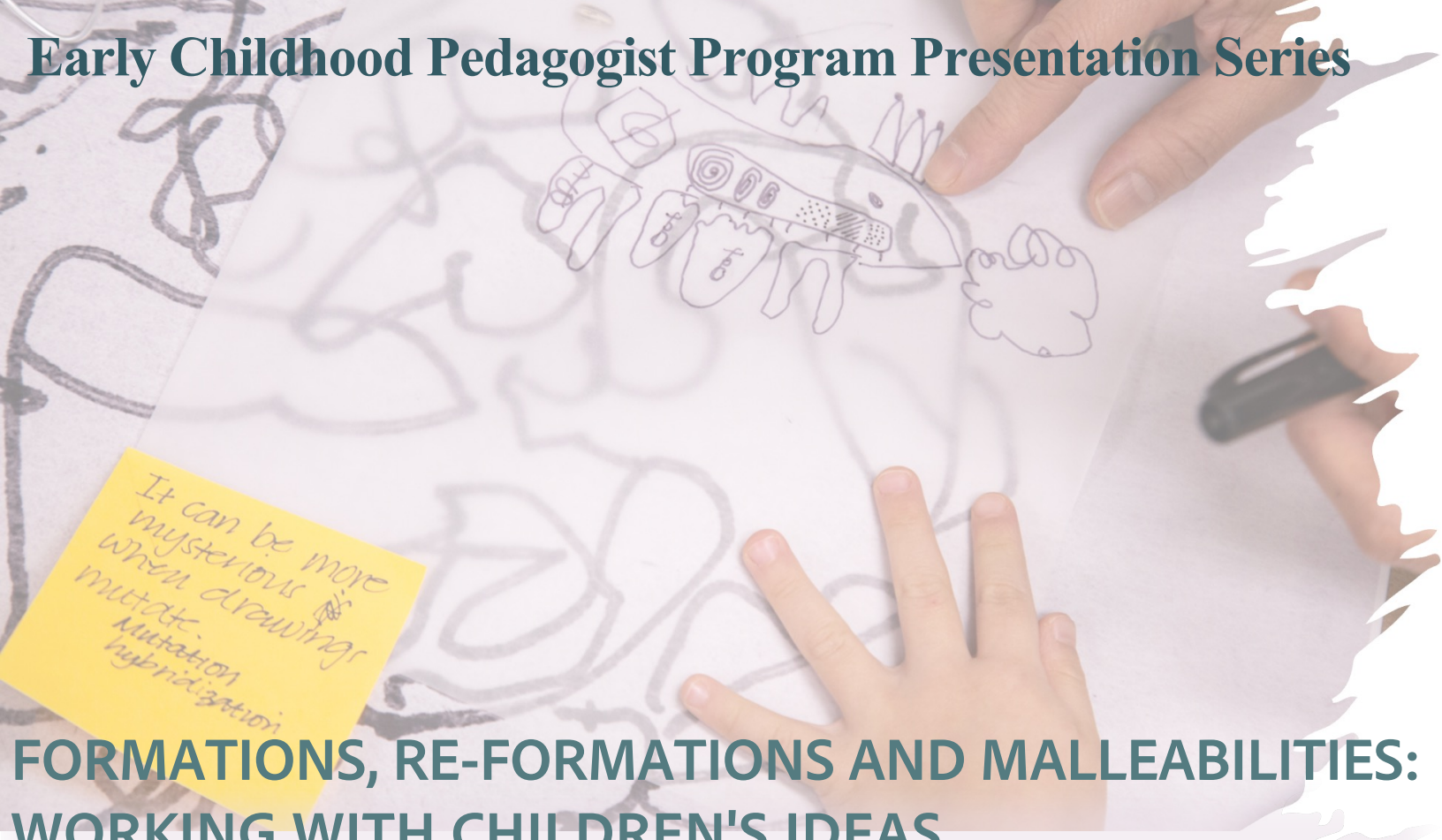


# Early Childhood Pedagogist Program Presentation Series
