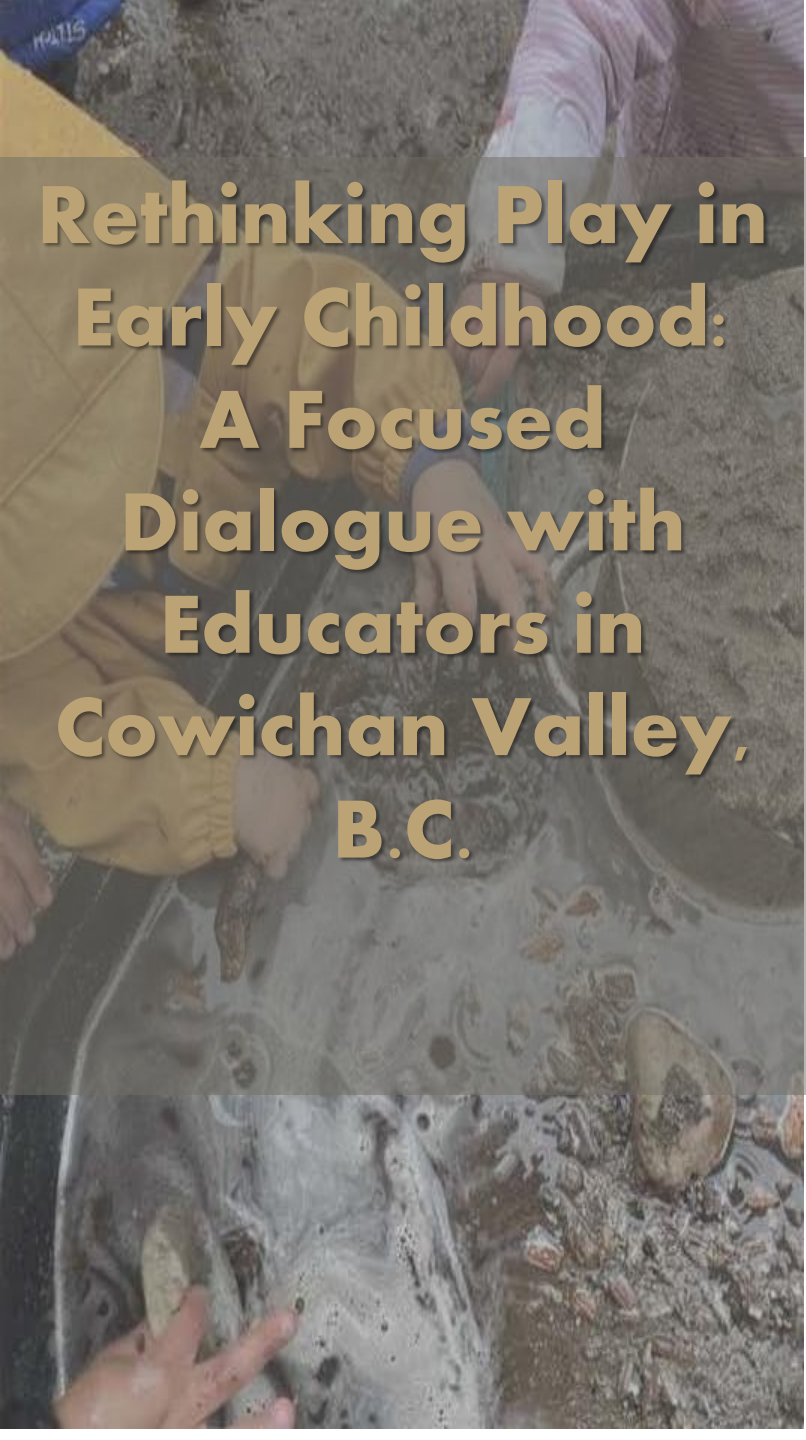




Rethinking Play in Early Childhood: A Focused Dialogue with Educators in Cowichan Valley, B.C.
